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SUPERINTENDENT TRAINING FOR IRONWORKERS: Ironworker superintendents are responsible for implementing an efficient site production process and maximizing profit while minimizing company liability. Ironworker superintendents serve as the contractor's representative on the jobsite and establish positive relationships with the end user, contractors, and other trades while ensuring that projects are delivered safely, on schedule, and within budget.

This 3-day, 24-hour course is designed to develop skilled ironworker superintendents. This course is appropriate for any member interested in improving their field supervision and management skills. Participants will learn the roles and responsibilities of the superintendent as well as how to manage project schedules, information, people, the job site, and safety. Participants will also learn communication skills, how to close out a project, and basic construction finance and law.

NOTE: This course is available to all ironworkers with a book number.

PRE-WORK INFORMATION: Participants will be requested to complete two brief self-assessment questionnaires prior to the start of class. The first self-assessment will focus on the individual's experience and will be sent two weeks prior to the course. The second self-assessment will focus on the individual's response to a project scenario and will be sent one week prior to the course.

Participants must bring a laptop computer to the course or a tablet that permits the downloading of materials onto the tablet.

IMPORTANT SAFETY PROCEDURES: Each participant will need to provide proof that they have been vaccinated to attend any indoor event in NYC, including this training event and indoor dining. Vaccination cards and temperatures will be checked upon entering the meeting room.
